Dear Parents/Guardians,

On behalf of Fell Elementary School, I would like to welcome you back! My name is **Mr. Omahr Ashe**, and I am the proud principal of Fell Elementary. We are already gearing up for an incredible new school year of teaching and learning. My entire team and I are excited and ready to return to school starting Monday, August 29th – *the first day of school*.

With the new school year quickly approaching, we will continue to focus on the core values of our mission and vision statement, with our primary goals of providing you with a safe, supportive and successful learning environment. It is our responsibility to you and your child to be unwavering in our commitment to their academic excellence and providing high-quality instruction. Further, the standards-driven instructional opportunities and the moral development that your child will receive at our school is unparalleled throughout the School District of Philadelphia.

We also know that strong partnerships with parents are fundamental to the educational success of our students. I am looking forward to a productive partnership with you to guarantee that our students can continue to achieve at their highest potential. As partners, we share the responsibility for the success of our students, and we ask that you support your child's learning by ensuring that:

- Your child attends school daily and arrives on time.
- Your child is dressed in our school uniform every day.
- Your child comes to school prepared, and ready for the day's learning.
- Your child completes all homework assignments given by teachers.
- Your child follows all of our school-wide rules and expectations.

Please familiarize yourself with the names/roles of our school staff members, bell schedules, dress code/cell phone policies and other school-wide procedures so that you can work towards our common goal - your child's academic growth and achievement. Please remember, cell phones are not permitted during the school day. Also, additional, up to date information regarding our school and/or district can be found in our Fell Student Family Handbook and/or by navigating to our school's website (https://fell.philasd.org) or the School District of Philadelphia's website (www.philasd.org).

First, school begins every morning promptly at 9:00 AM. Students in 3rd and 4th grade meet in the large cafeteria, which is also known as the PTA room. All other students go directly to the Auditorium, which can be accessed on the 9th Street side schoolyard. Students who arrive after 9:00 AM are considered late. Repeated lateness is considered a school disruption and may negatively affect

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your child's academic success. Please help your child be successful by making sure he/she is on time for school every day.

Next, the school day ends at 3:39 PM for all students. Students in Rooms 100, 107, 103 and 104 will be dismissed from the **Auditorium**. Students in Rooms 201, 203, 204, 300, 301, 302, 304 and 310 will be dismissed on the **9**th **Street side** of the building into the school yard. Students in Rooms 106, 108, 207, 208, 209, 305, 306, 307, 308 and 309 are dismissed on the **Hutchinson Street side** of the building into the school yard. Children who have not been picked up on time are brought to the Main Office to wait for their parent/guardian to arrive. Please pick up your child on time every day.

We do not permit parents/guardians to pick up his/her child from the classroom nor do we grant early dismissals after 3:15 PM. You must wait for your child in the schoolyard at the end of the day. For the safety of all of our children and staff members, any visitor's (including parents/guardians) must have a photo identification when entering the school building and he/she must report directly to the Main Office, this is district policy.

The Fell School uniform consists of a **navy blue top and tan bottom**. Gym uniforms are mandatory and they can be purchased in the Main Office after 9:30 AM each day. Navy sweats are permitted on gym days. Children who are not in the school uniform cannot remain in the classroom. They are sent to the Main Office in order to wait for you to bring the uniform. Repeated dress code violations may result in additional consequences.

Breakfast is available in the school cafeteria at 8:30 AM – 8:55 AM. It is free for all students. All children also receive a free lunch at Fell. We have a full-service lunch program. Students in kindergarten, first and second grade eat lunch at 11:45 AM. Students in third, fourth and fifth grade eat lunch at 12:30 PM. Students in sixth, seventh and eighth grade eat lunch at 1:15 PM. A fifteenminute student recess is included during the lunch period.

- Mrs. Dobias, School Nurse, should be consulted about medications and related health issues.
- Mrs. Spratley, School Climate Manager, can address safety, attendance and behavioral issues arising in our school community.
- Mrs. Bruno, School Counselor, can address social-emotional concerns and the overall well-being of our students.
- Mrs. Maiorano, SPECM, can address questions regarding special education policies and procedures.
- Mrs. Sosangelis, ESOL/Lead Teacher, can address support services for English learners. In the absence of the Principal, Mrs. Sosangelis serves as the Teacher-In-Charge.
- Mrs. Murzyn, Literacy Coach/Mr. Matthews, Math Coach, can address academic concerns and serve as the Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) Point Person for Academics.
